CONSERV Construction Supports Rural Maine Fire Department With Fire Truck Donation

- Don Brennan, the Chief Operations Officer at CONSERV Construction, has purchased a fire truck from the Suffern, NY Fire Department and will be donating the truck to the Jefferson, Maine Fire and Rescue Department.



The rural mid-coast Maine fire department is budget challenged – in need of a new fire truck. The donation has underlying sentiment for CONSERV – the Suffern fire truck is the same truck that was used to extinguish the fire at CONSERV’s corporate office back in February, 2009. Suffern Mayor, Dagan LaCorte, was quoted as saying “We greatly appreciate CONSERV’s generous donation. More than anyone, they realize the importance of making sure that volunteer fire departments have the proper resources to fight fires. I know the Suffern Fire Department is thrilled to be able to help a fellow department in need”.

Suffern’s 1992 American LaFrance engine will help Jefferson Fire and Rescue tremendously. Fire Chief Walter Morris said “The Jefferson, Maine Fire & Rescue Department was elated when we learned that Don was donating a fire truck. The truck will replace a 1963 fire truck which is breaking down and suffering from water tank leaks. The Suffern fire truck has the capacity to carry 1,000 gallons of water – with no fire hydrants in our rural area, this is a great upgrade. We’re eagerly awaiting the arrival of the new truck and the men are very excited about the training session we’ve

scheduled. This was unexpected and we're extremely grateful for what Don, Suffern, and CONSERV has done for us."

Chief Michael Stark, the Battalion Chief of the Suffern Volunteer Fire Department, said "I would first like to thank the Mayor and the village board for their continued support of the Suffern Fire Department. I would also like to thank Mr. Don Brennan for making this event possible by not only purchasing this apparatus and donating it back to the Suffern Fire Department but transporting to Jefferson, Maine at no cost to us. It gives us great pride to donate this apparatus to the Jefferson Fire and Rescue Volunteer Fire Department."

Don Brennan had this to say "While I've always appreciated the hard work and dedication of our volunteer fire department, after being the victim of a devastating fire last year, I have even more respect for what these brave men and women do. They risked their lives and braved frigid weather to make sure that the fire was safely put out. The members of the Suffern Fire Department are true heroes."
